TREASURER'S REPORT

The account balance is approximately \$53,000.00 with a significant number of invoices to pay for fall purchases.

The 2017-18 income tax return has been completed. Other topics related to the tax status of the committee were discussed.

The co-treasurers and other members of the committee will work on budgeting in the near future.

BOARD REMARKS

A short discussion of membership ensued with a detailed discussion being tabled to a future meeting. Total membership stood at 209 with income from memberships for the 2018-19 school year amounting to \$15,475.00. This compared favorably to the previous 2 school years.

COMMITTEE UPDATES

Spirit Wear

A new vendor was retained for the sale of letter jackets, and it has worked out well so far. The other vendors are still options if the community chooses to use them. The prices of each were discussed, with the new vendor having the lowest prices for similar products. The vendor rep is also very flexible for obtaining a fitting and to answer questions.

A discussion of the spirit wear sales at recent football games took place.

Geneva Ace Hardware continues to sell spirit wear on the committee's behalf. The display of the products and the methods of recording sales at and obtaining payments from the store were discussed. The subcommittee may come up with a better way to stock the store.

It was mentioned that a closet at GHS to store the inventory would help.

Concessions

Gross sales were approximately \$2,200.00 at the last home football game and \$300.00 at an event the previous Saturday morning.
