COMMITTEE UPDATES

Spirit Wear

New stock was added to Ace Hardware. Further discussion was tabled until next meeting.

Concessions

One of the coolers will be repaired in the coming weeks. A new one would be more expensive and would take longer to come on-line for use. It is owned by the school, not the athletic department or the Boosters.

According to Rich, there is enough concessions stock on hand to last through the remaining indoor events. Outdoor events coming up include the conference track meet and the regional softball tournament. Rich believes there is enough stock of sweets for these events as well.

The stock of bottled water, the current supplier, and the price point were discussed.

Maintenance and storage costs of the stock were discussed. Dave would like as much of the stock on hand sold before the end of the school year. A discussion of the remaining purchases and potential net and gross revenue from the remaining events were discussed. Rich indicated again that the current stock should be sufficient. Rick is taking care of a lot of needs, e.g., hospitality room food, through the school.

A new grill will be purchased prior to the start of fall sports.

Rich will retire from his Concessions Chair position prior to the start of fall sports. A new chair will be sought before then.

Jennifer asked about the assignment of concessions work to parents rather than asking for volunteers. The football team does it this way. Dave indicated that the girls' sports work with the current system. In other instances, more volunteers than are really needed are scheduled since some volunteers don't show up. Many parents volunteer repeatedly to fill spots. It's possible that students can volunteer, but they should not handle money.

Dave will take care of food for track and soccer this spring instead of Rich.

Trivia Night

Trivia Night has been postponed, and possibly cancelled, this year since no chair was found to run it. Support volunteers – 4 or 5 – are ready to assist should a chair be found. Alternate future dates were discussed.

The possibility of an online auction in lieu of the night was discussed.

Shamrock 3v3

John indicated that the event is scheduled for March 16th. A significant donation was received from Lume's.

T-shirts are given to all participants. A discussion of potential sponsors for/on the shirts was discussed.

The event schedule and fees were discussed. Referees and scorekeepers are needed.

TREASURER'S REPORT

Kim and Chris Peri reported on the status of the account. A discussion of the potential future expenses for upcoming events and team purchases as well as the upcoming payables ensued. The possibility of the purchase and installation of screens behind the goals for soccer games was discussed.

Some purchases may be contingent upon Trivia Night occurring.
