Amy – Trivia Night Chair

Membership numbers and fees were reviewed by the committee. Contributions are up significantly while the number of members is similar to previous years. It was considered that the effort of the coaching staff to arouse interest correlates with the memberships obtained from the various teams. Discussion ensued about the presentations the committee makes at the start of each team's season and how to improve them. Also discussed were the roles of the coaches, a return to finding parent liaisons or sponsors for each team, and the membership goals. The consensus was that involvement was the main goal.

Dates

MLK Day of Hoops – the volunteer and event schedules were reviewed. Jennifer will be present during the day, and Dave will be present in the evening to assist with closing down our operations.

Cheer conference Wednesday – Jennifer can take care of it.

Dance sectionals Saturday – a huge event that appears to be covered. It ends at 630pm, cleanup can begin at 600pm. Dance and cheer parents swap events to volunteer, but cheer has an event, so more volunteers are needed. It should work out.

Scholarship Update

There have been 4 applications already received. The scholarship was increased to \$1,000.00 for next year from \$500.00.

A discussion ensued concerning circumstances when the awarded student temporarily or permanently stops attending school. Some schools split the award automatically between semesters. A policy needs to be established.

It was agreed that the scholarship does not expire so it can be used when the student continues his/her education. The school should return the balance when applicable.

Trivia Night

Amy, the accidental committee chair, shared the progress on the event. The deposit was placed to hold the room at Riverview Banquets. Amy and 2 others are doing most of the work, meeting weekly. Sponsors are being sought for the auction. A downloadable trivia game package with an 80s/90s theme will be used for the night and the game.

Potential sponsors were discussed as well as donations from the community for the auction. The goal is 15 tables sold; the webstore link is live. Other questions were covered for Amy since she is new to the event including the master of ceremonies, additional volunteers that evening, etc. The budget for the evening was also reviewed.

Spirit Wear Sales

This discussion was tabled since Carolyn was not in attendance.

Discussion of the technology needed to use the Square and other forms of payment for sales ensued.

The sales of spirit wear not sanctioned by the District at various retail stores in the area was discussed. Dave indicated that this will be discontinued in the near future.

Concessions

Dan updated the committee on the status of the repair of the popcorn makers. Dave confirmed that the pretzel warmer is OK.

A discussion of the methods to track and account for sales and purchases ensued.

The mattress sale was again a success.
